Online booking for mass at St Walburga's from Monday 2nd November



Please help us to save admin time and make reserving a space at Mass more user friendly by trying out the custom-designed Mass booking system!

If you normally request booking by email, please try the online booking system instead. Online booking will be available from Monday 9.00 am

until Friday 9.30 pm for the Vigil Mass & Saturday 1.00 pm for the Sunday Mass. You can book a bench for up to 3 adults. If you are bringing an additional child, book for 3 and note in the comment box that your party includes a child. If you have a larger family group, book 2 adjacent benches (*make 1 booking, then close the booking page and re-open to make your 2nd booking*). If adjacent benches are not available, book the closest two benches and note in the comments that you are a family group and would like to/need to sit together. The administrator and the stewards reserve the right to alter bookings to enable family groupings and to make the best use of available benches.

Some benches will be reserved for phone booking for each Mass. *If you do not have internet access*, please phone the parish office between 10-12 Monday-Friday to request a reserved bench: 01274 583708. Phone booking closes at 12 Noon on Friday. Reserved benches will revert to 'available' on the online system.

To access the online booking go to the Parish website (www.stteresabenedicta.org). Click on the 'Mass booking' button at the top of the 'Our Worship' page. Please read the booking guidelines (*click button at top of the booking page*).

NB, we apologise to all parishioners who worship at St Aidan's. If the pilot at St Walburga's is successful, we will be rolling the booking system out to St Aidan's in December
