Silent Meditation: Several parishioners have asked if the Parish Silent Meditation Group which met weekly pre-Covid could be re-established. ALL are invited to attend a short meeting to discuss the possibility of setting the group up again. To discuss what is meant by the practice of silent prayer. What does it involve? How does it work? Why meditate in silence? Where does this fit in with our usual life of prayer or Eucharistic worship? The group followed the simple method suggested by the World Community for Christian Meditation (www.wccm.org) – there are such parish groups meeting regularly across Yorkshire, the UK and indeed globally. This and the long tradition of silent meditational prayer in the Church will be explained fully. No commitment whatsoever at this stage. Season Of Creation: In this season (September 1st to Oct 4th) we are invited to recite the *Prayer for Creation*. We are all at different stages along the paths of 'eco-conversion' as suggested by Pope Francis on his letter to all humanity '*Care for Our Common Home*' (*Laudato Si 2015*). As the threat facing humanity grows, as illustrated by the awful recent events in Libya, Pope Francis is to publish an annex to that letter on October 4th. A copy of the *Prayer* is available in the two porches. It begins: 'Creator of All, from your communion of love life sprung forth like a mighty river and the whole cosmos came into being. On this Earth of overflowing love, the Word was made flesh and went forth with the life-giving waters proclaiming peace and justice for all creation.' It ends: 'Bless us to walk together with all people of good will.... In the name of the One who came to proclaim good news to all creation, Jesus Christ. Amen.'
